BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SEEKS PUBLIC INPUT ON SECONDARY ROAD PROJECTS

ORANGE COUNTY, VA - The Board of Supervisors invites the citizens of Orange County to share input on road projects for potential inclusion in the Six-Year Plan for Secondary Roads.

The Six-Year Plan is adopted annually and is the plan in which the Board prioritizes secondary road projects and allocates Federal and State funding provided through the Virginia Department of Transportation to complete said projects. The Plan outlines spending for the transportation projects proposed for improvement or construction over the next six (6) fiscal years. Projects across the County may include hard surfacing, widening, bridge improvements, etc.

A formal Public Hearing for adoption of the Six-Year Plan will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, 2017. The hearing will take place in the Board Meeting Room, located in the basement of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia.

Public comment will be considered during the Public Hearing prior to adoption of the Six-Year Plan. Comment may also be submitted via email (asimpson@orangecountyva.gov) or mail (P. O. Box 111, Orange, Virginia 22960) prior to the Public Hearing.
