



The Orange County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 13, 2018, in the Meeting Room of the Gordon Building, located at 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia, to receive comments on, and consider, the following:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE (ZTA 18-01)

The Board of Supervisors will consider an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance which would permit microbreweries and microdistilleries in the Agricultural (A) zoning district as special use, in the Limited Commercial (C-1) zoning district as permitted use subject to certain limitations, and in the General Commercial (C-2) zoning district as permitted use. The amendment would also clarify the current definition for “agriculture” to include farm breweries, wineries, and distilleries subject to state code requirements and would add new definitions for “microbrewery” and “microdistillery.”

All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing and to present their views and/or to submit written comments. Related documents may be examined during regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, at the Office of the County Administrator, located on the second floor of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia.
