

MINUTES OF THE ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING March 8th, 2021

A meeting of the Orange County Electoral Board was called to order by the Chairman, Toni Warmack, on Monday, March 8th, 2021 at 10 a.m. in Voter Registration Office, located at 146 Madison Road, Orange, Virginia.

Attendees: Toni Warmack, Chairman; JoAnne Speiden, Secretary; Donna Harpold, General Registrar; Bridget Ramo Joyce, Elections Manager.

- I. The meeting was called to order and Jo Anne moved to accept the minutes of the last meeting, the Canvass of Votes, held on February 1st, 2021. Toni seconds, all in favor.
- II. EB member appointed
 - i. The Board appointed a new member: Lyn Lewis
- III. Reorganization of the Board:
 - i. Chair will remain the same: Toni Warmack, Vice Chair will be Lyn Lewis, and Secretary will remain the same: JoAnne Speiden. JoAnne moves to vote. All in favor.
- IV. Old Business:
 - i. Audit: Results came out as intended. Pull of 9 ballots. Outcome of Election was correct.

 - i. Preparations for June 8th Primary:

 - iv. PPE: will be sent by State if needed. We will continue to follow CDC and State Guidelines.
 - v. EB: Plans to be more visible at all precincts, with offset schedules of rotation.
 - ii. Office Staff:
 - i. Ginger, Assistant Registrar, will be leaving at the end of the month. Preparations are made to fill the part time position.
