

At a regular meeting of the Orange County Community Policy and Management Team (CPMT) held on Thursday, March 26, 2015 beginning at 1:00 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Sedwick Building, 146 Madison Road, Orange, Virginia. Mrs. Vines called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.

RE: NEW BUSINESS

RE: CLOSED SESSION

Mrs. Baker moved at 1:07 p.m. that we enter closed session pursuant to Virginia Code Section 2.1-344. At this time, cases in regards to the youth on the case agenda were reviewed and discussed.

Mrs. Baker then moved to exit closed session at 1:36 p.m., all were in favor.

The membership discussed a case in which the youth is doing very well and is making positive changes in their life. Members of the group shared their stories about this youth and how far they have come since coming into Orange CSA.

RE: GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVE

Mrs. Vines informed the membership that a Thinking for a Change class will begin in late April. The office is accepting referrals at this time. There needs to be a minimum of eight youth for the class to be held. In addition, the Positive Action Parenting class will be held at the same time. The location is still to be determined.

The Office on Youth is also partnering with Orange DSS to provide a resource fair on June 24th called "Get Connected Orange – Plug in to your Resources". The intention is to provide access for parents to as many resources Orange County has to offer. More information to follow.

Mrs. Ferrier informed the membership that they have gotten the green light to start the process of hiring a partner for Jeff Chervenak in the Orange CSU office.

Ms. Sitnik stated that they will be having an anger management group for adults led by Debbie Ball. She will look into a juvenile group for the youth referred in Orange. In addition, Mrs. Sitnik discussed "Accudetox" and how the CSB plans to offer this to their clients.

RE: ORANGE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Mrs. Baker informed the membership that the school administration has been very busy over the past several weeks. In addition, staff has been receiving training in traumatic brain injuries starting with concussions. The last training was held on March 24th and included a presentation on the Orange County Public School policies to the state. Mrs. Baker also stated that the schools will be offering a parent training next year in regards to the Orange program and that there will be a program on all three levels: elementary, middle and high school. A brief discussion followed.
