

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES

FEBRUARY 11, 2020

At a Worksession of the Orange County Board of Supervisors held on Tuesday, February 11, 2020, beginning at 4:00 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia. Present: James P. Crozier, Chairman; R. Mark Johnson, Vice Chairman; James K. White; and Lee H. Frame. Absent: S. Teel Goodwin. Also present: Brenda G. Garton, Interim County Administrator; and Alyson A. Simpson, Chief Deputy Clerk.

RE: ORANGE COUNTY ENTRANCE SIGNS DESIGN CONCEPTS

Lori Landes-Carter, Tourism Manager, provided an overview of the design process for the Entrance Signs CIP project, which included information on the following: development of the design concepts; support and involvement of the Tourism Advisory Committee; results from the community survey; determination of appropriate sign locations; individual components of the design concepts; and a presentation of the prepared design concepts for feedback from the Board.

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding: determination of the appropriate sign size based on roadway conditions; the proposed location of the Germanna Foundation sign versus the proposed location of the County's entrance sign; funding for the signs; potential community partnerships to assist with additional funding; cost estimates for each of the proposed design concepts; adherence to VDOT construction standards for the signs; standardization of sign designs across all the proposed locations; the potential to use off-site labor to fabricate the signs to limit costs and roadway interruption; use of pre-fabricated materials; the desire to refine the vertical design concept; and the potential for business sponsors to assist with landscaping and maintenance.

The Board took the information regarding the Entrance Signs design concepts under advisement, and there was no action taken at this time.
