

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES

MARCH 9, 2021

At a Worksession of the Orange County Board of Supervisors held on Tuesday, March 9, 2021, beginning at 4:30 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia. RE: REMOTE PARTICIPATION

Pursuant to the Board of Supervisors' Bylaws, Supervisor Marshall joined via Zoom video conference so that he could participate in the meeting remotely as he was out of town. As such, the minutes are required to reflect that Supervisor Marshall participated from South Carolina for the remainder of the meeting.

RE: REPORT FROM THOMAS JEFFERSON AREA COMMUNITY CRIMINAL JUSTICE BOARD

Neal Goodloe, Criminal Justice Planner, reviewed the Report for 2011-2019 that he had prepared for the Board. His presentation highlighted the following topics: population trends; reported crimes against people; reported crimes against property; reported crimes against society; drug and narcotics violations; felony drug certificates; an analysis of Orange County bookings at the Central Virginia Regional Jail (CVRJ); an analysis of Orange County intakes at CVRJ; statistics on lengths of stay at CVRJ; and expenditures for Orange County bed days at CVRJ.

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding: whether these statistics were trending similarly across the nation; intakes by age comparison; changes in lengths of stay; changes in specific statistics in correlation with felony probation violations; methods to help control some of the trends; and the ability to divert some inmates to receive mental health services versus incarceration.

The Board thanked Mr. Goodloe for his presentation.
