

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MINUTES

APRIL 27, 2021

At a Worksession of the Orange County Board of Supervisors held on Tuesday, April 27, 2021, beginning at 4:00 p.m., in the Meeting Room of the Gordon Building, 112 West Main Street, Orange, Virginia. Present: James P. Crozier, Chairman; R. Mark Johnson, Vice Chairman; James K. White; Keith F. Marshall; and Lee H. Frame. Also present: Theodore L. Voorhees, County Administrator; and Alyson A. Simpson, Chief Deputy Clerk.

RE: SECONDARY SIX-YEAR PLAN

Alyson Simpson, Chief Deputy Clerk, explained that this Worksession kicked-off the annual review and development of the Secondary Six-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2022 through 2027. She indicated that the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) had provided a packet of information to be used for reference during the discussion and turned the meeting over to VDOT staff.

Alan Saunders, Louisa Resident Engineer, reviewed the packet of information, highlighting the projected funding allocations; the types of funding available; the list of current projects in the Six-Year Plan and each project's status; and the recommended changes from VDOT for the new Six-Year Plan.

Discussion ensued among the Board regarding: the project scope for Chicken Mountain Road; the project scope for Greenwood Road; how the project segments were divided for Harbor Drive; the project scope for Matthews Mill Road; and the ability to advance projects sooner.

On the motion of Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. White, which carried by a vote of 5-0, the Board authorized staff to advertise for and schedule the public hearing on the Secondary Six-Year Plan on Tuesday, May 25, 2021, as presented.
