Mrs. Vines reported that the OY would be starting a new in-house GPS monitoring program for referred youth. This change will have a cost savings of \$7.90 per day, per youth being monitored. Also, staff will be attending Decision Points training. This program teaches youth a new way to look at how they respond to situations. More information to come.
