**FAMILY ASSESSMENT AND PLANNING TEAM ACCEPTING PARENT AND PRIVATE PROVIDER REPRESENTATIVE APPLICATIONS**

ORANGE COUNTY, Va. – The Orange County Office on Youth, on behalf of the Orange County Community Policy and Management Team (CPMT) is accepting applications for new representatives to be appointed to the Family Assessment and Planning Team (FAPT). This team meets two to three times per month, and appointees will be assigned to one or two of those meetings each month.

The CPMT manages Children’s Services Act (CSA) funding, programs, and policies in Orange County. The CSA is a law, enacted in 1993, which establishes a state pool of funds to purchase services for at-risk youth and their families. The state funds, combined with local community funds, are managed by local interagency teams who plan and oversee services.

The FAPT is a subcommittee appointed by the CPMT. It is responsible for meeting with at-risk individuals and families and developing service plans tailored to their needs. This team is seeking applications from enthusiastic parents interested in serving the community. Strong consideration will be given to applicants who have received FAPT services in the past.

In addition to the parent representatives, the Orange County CPMT is seeking one private provider representative. Private providers are businesses or organizations which provide some of the services outlined in service plans developed by the FAPT. The team invites the applications of providers who have a wide knowledge base and a desire to assist our youth and families.

Interested parties should complete and return all required information noted in the application packet by Friday, September 2, 2022. Fillable applications are accessible at [www.orangecountyva.gov/csa](http://www.orangecountyva.gov/csa). The CPMT will vote on proposed appointments during their September 2022 meeting, and appointees will be notified immediately to determine FAPT meetings they will be assigned to attend.
