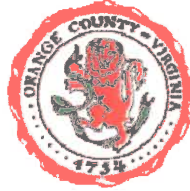

RE: RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE SIX-YEAR PLAN FOR SECONDARY ROADS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2019 THROUGH 2024 AND THE SECONDARY SYSTEM CONSTRUCTION BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

WHEREAS, Section 33.2-331 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, provides the opportunity for each county to work with the Virginia Department of Transportation in developing a Secondary Six-Year Road Plan; and

WHEREAS, this Board had previously agreed to assist in the preparation of this Plan, in accordance with the Virginia Department of Transportation policies and procedures, and participated in a Public Hearing on the proposed Plan (for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2024 as well as the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2019) on May 22, 2018, after duly advertised so that all citizens of the County had the opportunity to participate in said hearing and to make comments and recommendations concerning the proposed Plan and Priority List; and

WHEREAS, E. Alan Saunders, Louisa Resident Engineer, Virginia Department of Transportation, appeared before the Board and recommended approval of the Six-Year Plan for Secondary Roads for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2024 and the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2019;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, on this 22nd day of May, 2018, that since said Plan appears to be in the best interests of the Secondary Road System in Orange County and of the citizens residing on the Secondary System, said Secondary Six-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2024 and the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2019 are hereby approved as presented at the Public Hearing and as attached.
